01. Operations – Reservation Search

Overview

The 'Reservation Search' Utility in the Property Management System feature allows the user to display reservations by choosing from a large selection of search options. This feature also serves as an entryway for creating new reservations, changing existing reservation information, reviewing previous reservations, and accessing guest profiles that is associated specifically to the property.


Standard

Ensuring all properties, and respective employees, are adhering to the expected guidelines to maintain data integrity throughout the network, whilst performing operational duties.

Procedure

To utilise the 'Reservation Search' feature to retrieve the reservation required the below process must be followed:

- Select 'Reservation'
- Select 'Reservations Search'



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- Enter details 'Search' tab
- Select the required 'Search by' eg 'Surname'
- Select the 'Reservation Status'
